OK Channel 2022: above all it is a two-fold challenge - on one hand, the lack of means to help the daily life of disabled people, in particular, young people. On the other hand, the lack of financial resources for research into rare genetic conditions.

OK Channel 2022, is also Olivier's great commitment: achieve a sporting exploit, with his heart and his body, for Killian.

In September 2022, Olivier will swim across the English Channel.

In September 2022, Killian will be his biggest supporter.

The Association Faire un don

A non-profit making association regulated by the 1901 law, OK Channel has been created by Killian and Olivier's family and friends. Already more than 10 people are members of the association.

OK Channel is working in close collaboration with the association MITOLAB and the platform PRIOR.



This association was created 20 years ago, regrouping around 50 research scientists and including different objectives, (biochemistry, genetics, neurology,..). For Olivier's family, handball is a sport which is passed from generation to generation. This passion drove him to a preselection in the French youth team. Sadly an injury stopped him from living his Red-White-Blue dream. From this huge blow, he learnt this lesson:

« I had a choice to make: either continue persevering to attempt to reach a high level or continue sport to have fun with friends... »

He chose friendship and this led him to take up numerous sporting challenges. Triathlon, Swim and Run, 24-hour mountain bike treks, 600 km mountain bike treks.. And it's with his close friends that he has lived these adventures.

Today, it's a new friendship with Killian, which has propulsed him into this new adventure, which he admits himself is "a bit extreme". Swimming the English Channel in 2022.

For Killian's family, resilience is their strength. Operating theatres, they know them well. From his birth and until just recently, he has been operated on several times for hydrocephalus, scoliosis and breathing problems.

His dream today:

« To be able to work, to be completely independant, to live on my own in an apartment, and to go on holiday without my family. I'm very headstrong and brave, I think I'm capable of doing all these things. »

Today, Killian uses an electric wheelchair to get about. He takes part in various sporting activities such as wheelchair football, swimming and also artistic activities such as singing.

Killian likes being with others, meeting new people, talking and helping out when he can.
